

POP Program

The *Plenty of Parking (POP)* program is designed to make it easier and more affordable for you to do business in downtown Fargo. Look for the POP logo to find a participating lot.



- POP coupons are available at many downtown businesses. A coupon provides one hour of FREE parking at a POP lot or a one-way MAT bus ride.
- "After hours" parking is FREE in all surface POP lots between 6 p.m. and 8 a.m., except when an attendant is present or for special events.

Downtown Residential Parking Permit Program (DRP3)

Downtown residential parking permits allow residents to park on city streets and not be penalized by time-zone restrictions. This program is available on designated streets.

To obtain a permit, you must apply in person, submit a completed application and provide proof of residence in the downtown area. The fee for this permit is \$25 per month. Call 241-1474 for details.

Bike Lockers/Parking

Bike lockers are available for rent from the City of Fargo at the NP Avenue Lot, 2nd Avenue South Lot and the GTC garage. Contact Parking Service at 235-1618 for details.

Skyway Hours

The Skyway provides a convenient connection between parking, restaurants, retail stores and entertainment venues. The Skyway is open for use between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. weekdays, between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. Saturdays and during events at the Civic Center.



Time Zones

On-street time zone parking is in effect from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Outside of these hours and on City of Fargo holidays, the time zone restrictions are not enforced.

The time zone starts when the vehicle is parked. The City of Fargo uses electronic devices to identify the locations of parked vehicles. Chalk is no longer used. A vehicle parked for longer than the posted time zone allows, may receive multiple citations for each separate violation.

“Re-parking”

Vehicles must be moved off of either side of a street between two intersecting roads before the posted time zone restriction expires. The vehicle cannot be re-parked within that area for a minimum of 4 hours to avoid a re-parking violation.



Night Parking

Parking is FREE in all City owned off-street surface lots in the downtown area between the hours of 6 p.m. and 8 a.m., except when an attendant is present or for special events.

Streets within the central business district, which includes the area from the Red River west to University Drive and from 5th Avenue North to 1st Avenue South, have overnight parking restrictions throughout the year. Vehicles or trailers parked in violation of overnight parking restrictions may be ticketed or impounded by the Police Department.

East/West Avenues: on-street parking is restricted between the early-morning hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.

North/South Streets: on-street parking is restricted between the early-morning hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.
